Dear Resident,

I am writing to inform you that we will shortly be commencing block paving works to complete the District Centre along Greenwood Way at Great Western Park.

This work requires us to close a short section of Greenwood Way during the school summer holidays. We have obtained permission from the local authorities to put a short diversion route in place for the duration of these works, which will begin on Monday 17th July and are anticipated to last seven weeks. Thames Travel has also been notified and their service will run as normal except for this small diversion.

We appreciate – and would like to apologise for – the inconvenience this may cause residents, however we would like to assure everyone that this is the most appropriate time to carry out these works. From September, on-site amenities such as the University Technical College, GEMS Primary School, Aureus Secondary School, Asda Supermarket and McCarthy and Stone Care Home will be open. Construction works have now started on the public house and will soon commence on the community centre and nursery, with the aim of completing these prior to the school summer holidays in 2018.

As a result, this year's school summer holidays will be the time when the least amount of public traffic is using this road, and therefore represents the safest opportunity to close this section.

Clear signage will be in place to make all road users aware of the diversion route. No residential driveways will be impacted by these works and every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum throughout.
