Grass, skate park and play park can be opened first, MUGA later. Says it is a high priority. Nothing fundamental will be changed, no safety issues with equipment/layout. Tennis club have decided that they want to put a key fob system on the gates, this system is part of their business plan proposal which has been submitted to council but not TW.</p> <p>3.4 Issues with pump station on site - piping being CCTV assessed, lots of wipes and nappies found, needed unblocking over last weekend. Suggests working with GWPR to put out a message about not flushing wipes, "flushable" wipes aren't flushable!</p> <p>3.5 Allotments - small centre plot near farm open this year, large plot at the bottom of the site won't be ready until 2021.</p>	RB
